### **English (Literacy)**

This term we are focussing on narrative and storytelling. The children will explore the different story settings in York. and how we can use these to develop our own stories.

Throughout the autumn term the class book will be Tom's Midnight Garden.

We will use this text to help us write play scripts and letters.

We will further explore modern and traditional poetry through The Door and The Highwayman.

### **Mathematics**



In maths the children will be consolidating their previous knowledge and studying a range of mathematical concepts including:

- Place value
- Money and real life problems (please encourage your children to help with the shopping!)
- Multiplication and the use of division to find simple fractions
- The impact of multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100

The children will also be taught about the properties of some two and three-dimensional shapes.

### **Science**

The children will be following the topics of Materials and their properties.

This will link to our STEM project of designing a Time Capsule.

### **Information and Communications Technology (ICT)**

In ICT the children will be using Advanced Poster techniques. They will be using Spreadsheets to record science investigations


### **Design Technology**
